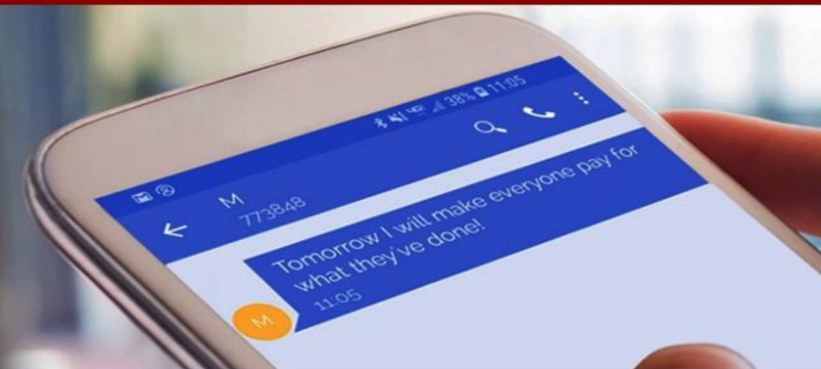


# Identifying and Intercepting School Violence through Cyber-Investigation



**Law Enforcement and School Officials** must know how to proactively respond to threats of school violence on-line. Especially when there is on-line "Leakage" threatening students and school personnel.
